ORDER

Amendment to Revised Consolidated Guidelines on the measures to be taken for containment of Covid-19 in the State

Reference : Department of Revenue and Forest, Disaster Management, Relief and Rehabilitation ,
Mantralaya, Mumbai- 400 032 No: DMU/2020/CR. 92/DisM-1, dated: 2nd May 2020

In continuation to the order No: DMU/2020/CR. 92/DisM-1, Dated: 2nd May 2020 of the State Govt. and in exercise of the powers, conferred under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee, hereby issues orders to amend the following in the consolidated revised guidelines order dated 2nd May 2020 for the strict implementation by the concerned authorities of all the departments in the state of Maharashtra

- 1) The following proviso will be included in para 7(ii)(g) pertaining to red zones.

*However Sub-registrar offices , RTO offices and Dy. RTO offices will be permitted to function ,except in containment zones, with following conditions
Sub-registrar offices may function with up to 5 personnel.
RTO offices and Dy. RTO offices may function with 10% of clerical strength.*

- 2) In orange and green zones , the existing guidelines permit functioning of Government offices. Accordingly all Sub-registrar offices , RTO offices and Dy. RTO offices will be permitted to function by the district collectors and municipal commissioners, except in containment zones.
- 3) Any deviation from the directives contained in 1) and 2) will need prior approval of committee consisting of ACS (Finance), ACS (Revenue) and ACS(Transport).

This amendment will come into operation from 18th May 2020.
