AERODROME SAFEGUARDING CIRCULAR (ADSAC) 3 OF 2020

<u>Subject: Capacity Building at AAI Airports - Effective Utilization of</u> <u>Surveyor-Cum-GIS Analysts and Survey Equipment - reg.</u>

1. Introduction

- 1.1. Control & monitoring of obstacles is the responsibility of the concerned airport operator discharged by the Airport Director or the Chief Executive Officer as the case may be. The procedures for control & monitoring of obstacles and the constitution of the Aerodrome Safeguarding Team have already been circulated through ADSAC 02 of 2019.
- 1.2. For enhancing the aerodrome safeguarding mechanism, i.e, control & monitoring activities at the AAI airports, by height regulation of the buildings and structures in the vicinity of airports, a few capacity building measures were approved by Chairman, AAI.
 - 1.2.1 Survey equipment, viz. One set of Electronic Total Station and Two sets of DGPS/ DGNSS, etc were purchased from M/S. Trimble and provided to twenty (20) major airports. (Annexure 1)
 - 1.2.2 Thirty-three (33) nos. of surveyor-cum-GIS analysts were hired by AAI from M/s. Broadcast Engineering Consultants India Ltd (BECIL), New Delhi, a Govt. of India undertaking and posted at 20 major AAI airports. (Annexure 1)
- 1.3. It is planned to utilise the above resources, stationed at twenty airports, to cater to the survey requirements of all AAI airports and all off-site Nav-Aid installations.

Aerodrome Safeguarding Circular 3 of 2020 Capacity Building at AAI Airports – Effective Utilization of Surveyor-cum-GIS Analysts and Survey Equipment

2. Purpose

- 2.1. The purpose of this Aerodrome Safeguarding Circular (ADSAC) is to promulgate the detailed procedures to be followed by the Airport Director / Aerodrome Safeguarding Team of an airport, for effective utilization of surveyor-cum-GIS analysts and to lay down the job responsibilities of surveyor-cum-GIS analysts.
- 2.2. This ADSAC explains the process of;
 - 2.2.1. Reporting of surveyor-cum-GIS analysts,
 - 2.2.2. Attendance & working hours of surveyor-cum-GIS analysts,
 - 2.2.3. Salary and other allowances of surveyor-cum-GIS analysts,
 - 2.2.4. Job responsibilities of surveyor-cum-GIS analysts,
 - 2.2.5. Facilities to be provided to surveyor-cum-GIS analysts by the Airport Director concerned and;
 - 2.2.6. Nomination of Nodal Officer at CHQ for surveyor-cum-GIS analysts.

3. Scope / Applicability

This ADSAC applies to all those major 20 airports where the surveyor-cum-GIS analysts have been posted and the survey equipment were provided, **(Annexure-1)** all those AAI airports, which are linked for survey related works with their respective Parent Airport **(Annexure-2)** and Off-site Nav-Aid Installations.

4. Cancellation

4.1. Nil

5. Effective date

5.1. This ADSAC will be effective from the date of its issue.

6. Reporting of Surveyor-cum-GIS Analysts

6.1. The newly hired surveyor-cum-GIS analysist shall report to the Airport Director of the Station of their Posting or to the executive authorised by the Airport Director for this purpose.



7. Attendance & Working Hours of Surveyor-cum-GIS Analysts

- 7.1. The attendance of the surveyor-cum-GIS analysist shall be forwarded to CHQ on email ID pradeepd@aai.aero and kksoni@aai.aero latest by 05th of the subsequent month, so that the salaries may be released by CHQ to M/s. BECIL in time.
- 7.2. The Working hours are as per the normal duty hours of AAI at the airport.
- 8. Salary and other allowances of Surveyor-cum-GIS Analysts.
- 8.1. The salary will be disbursed by M/s. BECIL. AAI CHQ will release the salary amount to M/s. BECIL. The other allowances, including TA/DA, when travel plan duly authorised by the Airport Director concerned, shall be applicable as detailed in the work order of AAI to BECIL. (Annexure 3)
- 9. Job Responsibilities of Surveyor-cum-GIS Analyst.
- 9.1 The surveyor cum- GIS analyst(s) shall be under the administrative control of the Airport Director concerned and shall work in close coordination with the Aerodrome Safeguarding Team of the airport, to prioritise the survey tasks.
- 9.2 The Airport director concerned shall communicate these Job Responsibilities to the surveyor-cum-GIS analyst(s).
- 9.3 Maintain a high degree of professionalism and integrity in discharging their responsibilities.
- 9.4 Verification of the site coordinates and elevation for the sites for which NOC applications have been received.
- 9.5 Undertake Survey of the suspected unauthorised buildings which have violated or likely to violate height regulations, in the vicinity of the airport, as decided and directed by the Aerodrome Safeguarding Team.
- 9.6 On applicants' request to Airport Director, provide the Site Coordinates and Elevation Certificate after due survey of the site, to the NOC applicants on chargeable basis. The charges & the Format for issuing the Certificate have been defined in GIS Circular 02 of 2019. This activity may commence from 01.04.2020. The certificate so prepared shall be countersigned by the member of the Aerodrome Safeguarding Team, duly designated by the Airport Director.



- 9.7 Shall be responsible for conducting Event surveys at the airport, Aeronautical data management, Quality Control of surveyed data etc. The survey data of the aerodrome shall be forwarded to Survey/ Cartography section, CHQ for verification/ publication.
- 9.8. Travel to the allocated Network Airports (As listed in Annexure 2), upon instructions from the Airport Director of the Airport of their posting, to carry out tasks listed from 9.3 to 9.7 above.
- 9.9 Travel to off-site Nav-Aid installations, as directed by the Airport Director concerned, to execute survey related works. TA/DA & overtime of the surveyors cum GIS analysts would be governed by AAI policy and is equivalent to entitlement of Manager post in AAI as approved by the competent authority.
- 9.10 To assist the CHQ survey team, during the periodical survey of airports by AAI CHQ team, at designated intervals in accordance with Aeronautical Survey Manual.
- 9.11 Execute any other survey/GIS related work that may be allocated by GM(Carto) or GM(ATM-DoAS), AAI CHQ, in coordination with the Airport Director concerned, as per operational requirements, at any of the AAI airports or off-site CNS facilities etc.
- 9.12 To optimise the use of survey equipment and maintain the same in good working condition at all times, paying extra care during transport and handling. Also, maintain the calibration certificates of the equipment and their regular maintenance as per the annual maintenance contract.

10. Facilities to be provided to the Surveyor-cum-GIS Analysts by an airport.

- 10.1. Suitable office space, computer, office stationery, etc. may be provided for his/her efficient working. Also, transport to the survey site may be arranged by the Airport Director.
- 10.2. Survey equipment may be handed over to the surveyor-cum-GIS analysts for their operations/maintenance and safe up-keep.
- 10.3. The arrangement of transport to the surveyor, locally or to other networked airports or off-site Nav-Aid installations, when so deputed, shall be the responsibility of the Airport Director of the parent airport.
- 10.4. A dedicated transport may be provided to the surveyor cum GIS analysts of the airport, on a regular basis, to carry out their assigned functions effectively.

- 12. **Validity:** This ADSAC will remain valid till it is amended or withdrawn or incorporated in the Aerodrome Safeguarding Manual.
- 13. **Document Control and feedback:** This ADSAC has been issued by the office of ED (ATM-DoAS) with the approval of the Directorate of Operations and Directorate of Survey and Cartography, AAI.

Terms & conditions :-

- AAI will make Quarterly advance payment against the Bank Guarantee submitted by BECIL.
- BECIL admin charges shall be payable @ 5 % on the negotiated rate/salary quoted by the empanelled agency.
- iii) Empanelled agency administrative charges @ 15% to 10% (which shall be included in the rate/salary quoted by Empanelled agency) & the benefit of difference amount of 5% will be passed to AAI on account of discount provided on empanelled rate specified in Annexure-1, as a special case which is applicable on all the offices of AAI across India.
- The CTC package of the contractual resources/GIS Consultant/Project associate covers local travelling and other allowances. If any outstation travelling is required, the same shall be reimbursed as extra as per entitlement decided by AAI. All the claims will be routed through BECIL after confirmation from the AAI controlling officer. Travel and Hotel accommodation during outstation tour arrangement will be done by AAI. DA claims of contractual resources during outstation tour will be settled by BECIL after its payment is received from AAI. Such claims may be settled once in a quarter and to be paid by BECIL to the contractual resources within 10 days from the date of receipt of the same from AAI.
- BECIL shall be responsible for the safety and welfare (including health) of the contractual resources/GIS Consultant/Project associate made available to AAI. (AAI hereby agrees to pay BECIL towards the cost of Medical and Accident Insurance provided to contractual resources/GIS Consultant/Project associate for the respective cover amounts agreed to as per the prevailing premium thereof, initially and during subsequent renewals and the respective cost will be a part of the CTC. BECIL shall comply with applicable provisions of all safety and welfare legislations and particularly with Contract Labour Act/ Building and other Construction workers Act/ Shops and establishment Act as applicable for carrying out the assignment. BECIL is required to get ESI card made for each person deployed to work with AAI as contractual resources/GIS Consultant/Project associate -within 1(one) month of the joining of such a person. In case ESI card is not made and there is any medical emergency, expenditure incurred by the staff shall be deducted from the payment to be made
- wi) Where ESI Act is not applicable, BECIL shall make available equivalent insurance coverage under the provisions of Employees Compensation Act (EC Act 1923) and medical benefits to manpower provided by them. BECIL shall arrange for necessary- ESI / EC cover & medical even for any staff deployed for very short duration under the agreement.
