

meanwhile, the Designated Officer of the Municipal Corporation may be granted liberty to decide any objection that the petitioner might wish to lodge in the meanwhile.

3. The statement of Mr.Bubna is recorded.

4. We dispose of this writ petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to object to the impugned notice within 7 (seven) days from date. Thereafter, the Designated Officer shall afford the petitioner an opportunity of hearing and proceed to pass a reasoned order while disposing of his objection. Once such final order is received by the petitioner, he shall be at liberty to pursue his remedy in accordance with law.

5. None of the points raised by the petitioner in the writ petition has been examined by us on merits and all such points are left open for being raised in the objection to the impugned notice.

6. There shall be no order for costs.
