Mr.Sonpal, learned special counsel submits that two notifications have been issued, one by the State of Maharashtra and the other by the Central Government, wherefrom he submits that transfer development rights in respect of residential apartments stands exempt from payment of GST; even otherwise the liability is on the developer.
- 3. Since this may have a bearing on the adjudication of the writ petition, we are of the view that Mr.Sonpal should file an additional affidavit to bring on record the above notifications.



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4. Mr.Mishra, learned counsel appearing for the Central Government may also file additional affidavit.
